

i-Ready Diagnostic and Instructional Reading and Math Program

i-Ready is an web-based diagnostic and instruction tool that provides personalized instruction to students in reading and math.

Diagnostic:

Children take the diagnostic three times a year at school. Results of the diagnostic assessment will be sent home in your child's Friday Take Home Folder. The reading and mathematics adaptive diagnostic pinpoints student needs down to the sub-skill level.

Reading domains include:

- Phonological Awareness
- High Frequency Words
- Vocabulary
- Comprehension: Literature
- Comprehension: Informational Text

Math domains include:

- Numbers and Operations
- Algebra and Algebraic Thinking
- Measurement and Data
- Geometry

Instruction:

The individualized instruction is based on the results of the diagnostic assessment. The program provides rigorous instruction and practice with Ready Common Core

At school, your child will have the opportunity to utilize i-Ready instruction during centers, library, computer, Stream, and after school care. We also encourage children to access i-Ready from home.
