Terranova Testing Tips and Procedures

- Tardy Students - Tardy students will not be permitted to enter the classroom until there is a break in the testing schedule. Most of the assessments will be administered in the morning.
- Students should eat a full breakfast at home.
- Students should go to bed early so they are refreshed in the morning.
- Students should have several #2 pencils and a book to read.
- The Terranova is an achievement test, not a proficiency test. Proficiency tests are those in which students have been taught all the concepts and are now being tested on whether or not they “got it.” Achievement tests include content students may not have been specifically taught, but they could be expected to have mastered according to their cognitive ability. Therefore, some test questions may be more difficult than others and some material may be new to students.
- Calculators are not permitted.
- Guessing - Students are encouraged to attempt all questions. They should read each question carefully and make their best attempt answering.
- Morning Prayer - Morning prayer will take place in the classroom the week of 3/2. However, we will have Mission Wednesday on Wednesday, 3/4.
