


What is the Rice Bowl Foundation?

- An organization through Catholic Relief Services that raises money to help over 127 million people around the world
 - It invites us to reflect on our Lenten sacrifices and how they can help families around the world overcome the challenges of hunger and poor nutrition
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Who does it help?

- The Rice Bowls are given to those who are hungry and have little access to resources
 - It mainly helps children and families in Africa
 - 25% helps demolish poverty in our local diocese
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What can we do?

- As a school community, we are going to individually raise money to donate to the foundation
- Each person will receive a bowl and will earn (on their own) money to give as a donation




How do I earn money?

- The concept is to earn the money, not just be given it
- Lent is about sacrifices, so we should sacrifice as well to help others
- You can earn money by helping out around the house
- Ex: doing dishes, walking the dog, folding laundry, cleaning room, etc.

 - Once you have raised your money, you can bring the bowl to school to give to your homeroom teacher
