- 3. The only restroom open, during the confession schedule, is located in the maintenance garage.
- 4. Confessions will take place under the Porte-co-chere.
- 5. Folding chairs, for your convenience, will be lined up six feet apart outside near the Porte-co-chere.
- 6. Our deacons will facilitate and coordinate the confession line.
- 7. If you are ill, or if anyone in your household is ill, please stay home!
